Under Kentucky law, a farm animal activity sponsor, farm animal professional or other person does not have a duty to eliminate all risks of injury of participation in farm activities. KRS 247.402. There are inherent risks of injury that you voluntarily accept and assume if you participate in the horse show, which is a farm animal activity.
