

## Class Descriptions

1. Boxing Only - Run a simplified reining pattern, signal for a cow, and demonstrate horses ability to hold the cow on the end of the arena. Judge will signal the end of the run.
2. Boxing Only – Ohio University Students only
3. Ranch Cutting – A judged event in which the horse and rider are to demonstrate the ability to cut and pen a cow using skills as they would apply in a ranch situation. Time limit – 2 1/2 minutes
4. Californio Ranch Riding – Horses are to demonstrate the walk, trot, and canter both directions of the arena and perform other maneuvers at the judges' discretion. Credit to be given for traditional gear and dress. Sponsored by Heartbreak Ridge Performance Horses, Skip Rulen & Kelly Pinkston
5. Ranch Roping – Select one cow from the herd and demonstrate the horse and riders ability to rope a cow with the least amount of stress on the cow. Excessive running of the cows will be penalized. It is not necessary to catch, however, non catches will not place above catches. This is a judged event with a 90 second time limit.
6. Little Buckaroo – Walk/trot 12 and under
7. Cow Maneuverability – Judged event that requires a three person team to take three cows from the herd and drive them through an obstacle course. Time limit 3 minutes
8. Working Cow horse – Exhibitors work a reining pattern then signal for a cow. The horses must box the cow on one end, take the cow down the long fence and make 1 turn in each direction, then take the cow to the center of the arena and circle cow 360° each direction.

Stalls, electric, and camper hookups available: Stalls \$20.00 (one horse per stall), Campers \$20.00 per hookup- Dogs must be on a leash!

**Directions: From Columbus-** 1-270 to US 23 South; go south on us 23 approximately 2 hours until reach US 52; head east on US 52 for approximately 12 miles; merge into left lane when you reach Greenup bridge and take Franklin Furnace/Ohio Horse Park exit; turn hard right at bottom of over pass, go straight to Ohio Horse Park. **From Cincinnati:** follow SR 32 east, then US 23 south to Portsmouth, then turn left on US 52 heading east. **From Lexington:** follow I-64 east to SR 180 at exit 185, going north; SR 180 turns into US 60; take US 60 north across the Ohio River, then follow US 52 heading west. **From Charleston:** follow I-64 west to US 52; head north on US 52 across the Ohio River, then, staying on US 52, head west.
